



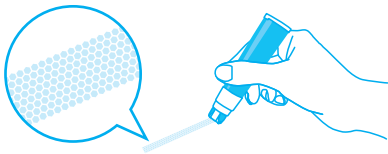

- 2 Cut out the turtle with School Scissors.



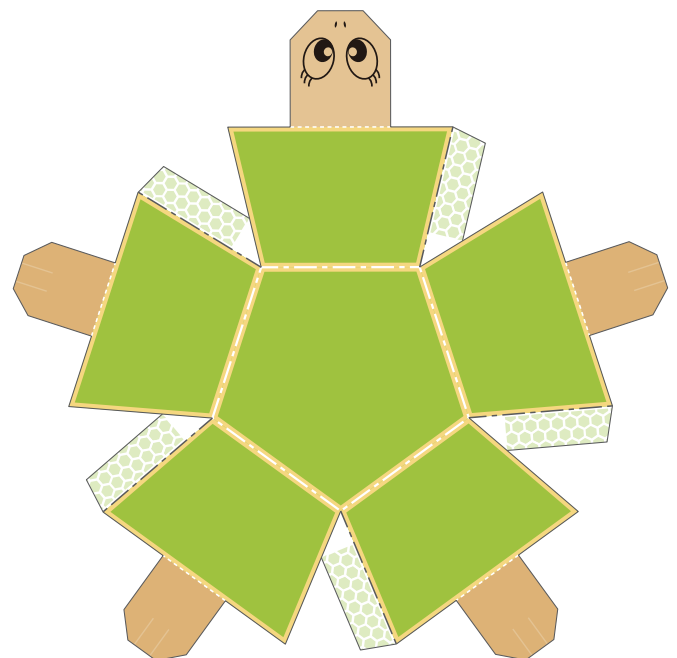
